

**Project:** Which future for young people in Europe ?

**Subject:** The project aims at giving young people the opportunities to be actors of the policies they are involved in and wants to promote the European dimension through young people inviting them to be interested in the development and future of Europe in order to reinforce their involvement in local democratic life.

The project aims to:

- contribute to create an European citizenship awareness in young people;
- improve knowledge of Europe through youth's opinions;
- compare the different points of view of young people from the European countries about their future in Europe.

The project involves 2.400 young people aged between 15 and 20 years, coming from the four partner countries which represent a sample investigation developed by the University of Limoges according to the dissemination level of European citizenship sensibility among youth.

The investigation is realized through the on-line fulfilment of a questionnaire on web site <http://www.eurofutur.eu> from April up to the middle of May 2009.

Following actions to questionnaire processing:

- qualitative and quantitative analysis of the results of 2.400 questionnaires;
- organization of an exchange Forum with 100 young people from the countries involved into the project; the the results of the inquiry will be published in a document.
