
Project: **Breaking the barriers - Improve access to long life learning**

Subject: The purpose of the project is to help developing a new strategy for centres of learning through the creation and dissemination of an innovative educational instrument for adult education.

The main objective is to create a place of study, reflection and confrontation in order to obtain a common methodology for identifying the most suitable forms and instruments to overcome the barriers to education faced by adult learners, especially those having a low level of education.

On the basis of sharing the successful past experiences of the partners in their cultural and territorial contexts, the strong and weak points of these projects will be identified.

The next step will be to highlight the characteristics that have favoured access by adult learners with a low level of education and to attempt to find a common method of working which can then be applied in the various social and cultural contexts of the partners involved in the project.

The final objective is to strengthen the contribution of permanent learning to social cohesion, active citizenship, intercultural dialogue and to encourage and facilitate the culture of learning in order to offer modern didactic methods and production of materials useful for the dissemination of the projects activities.
